



Remote Learning Plan

Remote Learning will happen ONLY if the state mandates us to shut down in person learning.

This will be different from remote learning in the previous spring semester in the sense that everything will be graded as if we were in regular in person school. New material will be introduced. The platform NHCS will use will be google classroom. Lessons will be posted through this platform. Students will be taught how to use this platform from the beginning of school. Parents will be given tutorials and asked to use google classroom early on in the year to prepare if schools were required to switch to remote learning. Exactly how remote learning will work is still in the planning stages, and we will release this information as soon as we have the final plans.

Remote Learning Discounts:

We are very appreciative to all of our families who stood behind NHCS last year during a very uneasy time for all of us. I feel our staff did an excellent job last year during remote learning. Now that we have that experience under our belts, we will improve in many areas to make the experience better for everyone involved.

New Horizon wants to say thank you for supporting our school if we were to have to switch to remote learning again. We will offer a 30% discount per day after a 5 day grace period of remote learning. On the 6th day your discount will be put into effect if you choose to accept it. This will apply toward every student you have attending NHCS. Families will only get reimbursed/credited for days that are mandated by the state to be remote learning due to COVID-19. *This does not include any type of isolation or quarantine days.*

If families wish to withdraw from NHCS during remote learning, they will receive a refund on days not in attendance but will not be allowed to re enroll during the 20-21 school year. You will be allowed to return in the 21-22 school year.

We will send an informational email if the time comes, and you will have to respond saying you want the discount. We are grateful for your continued support through this uncertain time. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact me.
